- Does your supply chain flow freely from your plant all the way to the end consumer?
- Are you satisfied with the customer service you receive from your current packaging supplier?
- Does the quality of your current packaging design and materials meet your expectations?
- Do your current supplier's shipping services meet your company's needs?
- Does your sales representative address your needs, listen to your concerns, and strive to create win-win situations?
